Items may be refused for some very good reasons. Free Pile volunteers may decline a donation if, in their judgment, it is not in clean, or in usable condition, contains hazardous waste or if they are unable to assist with larger items due to risk of injury.

We gladly accept (in gently used condition and in working order):

- Clothing, Shoes and Boots, Hats, gloves, mittens and scarves
- Books, Media (Blu-Ray, DVDs, CDs, Vinyl Records, Tapes, etc.)
- Musical Instruments
- Games, toys, bicycles, and sports equipment
- Housewares: dishes, pots and pans, glassware, food storage containers (reusable), kitchen utensils, lamps and small appliances
- Paper Goods
- Hand tools and small power tools
- Domestics: linens, curtains, blankets, area rugs, etc.
- Outdoor furniture, lighting, BBQ Grills, and accessories
- Camping equipment, heaters, unopened batteries, tents and tarps
- Electronics: Stereos, radios, VCRs, DVD players, computers, cameras, etc.
- Art (paintings, prints, pottery, glass, etc), Art Supplies, Craft Items & Supplies, and Sewing Supplies
- Seasonal & Holiday Items
- Pet Related (No perishable food, treats, or toys)
- New/Unused Items

We are unable to accept:

- Construction debris
- Electronic devices containing lead and mercury
- Flammable Products
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Perishable Food Items
- Hazardous Wastes (paints, fuels, solvents, oils or equipment containing these)
- Household or Industrial Chemicals such as pesticides, paint, paint thinner, drain cleaner, oven cleaner, aerosols and other environmentally unfriendly waste products.
- No automotive hazardous waste such as tires, lead acid batteries, additives, gasoline, oils, antifreeze, etc.
- Inoperable hand tools or small power tools
- Small appliances which are not fully operational
- Box or CRT TV's or computer monitors of any size
- Any broken or damaged item that is not usable
- No Weapons & Explosives such as fireworks, guns, bows and arrows, ammunition, hunting knives, etc.
- Animal Products (antlers, bones, furs, ivory, etc.)
- Medical Supplies
- Open Products (cleaning, cosmetics, paint or varnish)
- Plastic Packaging
- Propane Tanks
- Used Undergarments (bras, panties, or underwear)
- Used Pillows, Mattress & Box Springs
